WHAT KIND OF DOCUMENT?

- Part of the 'Pauline Corpus'
- A letter
- Sent from a superior to his subordinate
- Relates to church concerns

WHAT KIND OF DOCUMENT?

- One of the 'Pastoral Epistles' (with 1 and 2 Timothy)
- Concerned with care for established Christian communities, and with their leadership
- Encourages particular choices and actions, with reasons

A LATER PAULINE LETTER

- Restates and reapplies Paul's message and teaching for a new context, especially
 - A different church structure
 - A different problem

A DIFFERENT CHURCH STRUCTURE

- Churches are in the early stages of becoming more settled and structured
- •Letter is addressed directly to 'trans-local' leaders who care for churches in more than one centre
- But it also speaks indirectly to the local leaders
 they appoint and the people they lead

A DIFFERENT PROBLEM

- Teachers of heresy and immorality
- Church members may be won over
- Teaching based on Jewish myths and practices of abstinence

WHY WAS TITUS WRITTEN?

- To encourage leaders to sustain the churches...
- by maintaining right belief and practice...
- through good leadership...
- and according to Paul's gospel...
- on the basis of his apostolic authority

HOW CAN IT SPEAK TO US?

- Protecting the church against false teaching
- Holding to the basic Christian faith and lifestyle
- Qualities and actions required of leaders
- All based on Paul's apostolic authority
