## **House group study questions – Titus 2:1–10**

- 1. Spend some time looking at the lists of instructions that apply to each of you.
  - a. Which of these qualities do you find easiest and which hardest?
  - b. Which do you think are most popular in our society and which least popular?
- 2. What motives does this passage give us for pursuing (or avoiding) these qualities? Look especially at verses 1, 5, 8 and 10.
  - a. What might we do if there is a conflict between what God approves and what society approves?
- 3. Look at verses 9 and 10.
  - a. Do you think this passage endorses the institution of slavery?
  - b. What other reasons could there be for not challenging it here?
- 4. The passage expects different kinds of behaviour from different groups, and it requires wives to be subordinate to their husbands.
  - a. Discuss how we might interpret tough passages like this today.
  - b. Does it still apply to us, and if so, how?
